DC.Rights.Ownership	Information related to ownership rights held over the resource or specific object.	
DC.Rights.Terms	Terms and conditions for use of resource or object.	
Note	Free text notes about the object or data.	
Submitter	Name of person and/or organization that submitted the object to the collection. Use LC authorized name if possible.	
Mediastring	Connects the object to the metadata. Delimited with semicolons.	ImageDirectory/ ImageName; Number of images; Derivative sizes; MIME type
MediaRights	Rights specific to this media version.	
Update	Data record was completed. Use ISO 8601	Auto entered by database.
